RESIDENCE PROGRAM FOR YOUNG ARTISTS AND RESEARCHERS

PIPES is a collaborative project of four European cultural associations. It involves Participatory Investigation of Public Engaging Spaces of communication with highly creative and technologically innovative ambitions. Our very highly ambitious main objective is to change the general mindset towards communication by creating a new visual language. The PIPES residency at ZKM | Karlsruhe is a short-term program where creative communication and collaboration among researchers and artists of various disciplines and with different cultural backgrounds contributing to develop a new visual language.

The program lasts 14 days during which the participants are welcome to work in the inspiring and well equipped surrounding of ZKM | Karlsruhe, develop their works with peers under the guidance of Prof. Michael Bielicky and other tutors, joining the annual Beyond Symposium for Future Design as well as attending a round-table discussion about Future Design of Global Communication with the PIPES-team and invited guests.

- Artworks and cultural products of 2D-digital-drawing & design e.g. pictograms, or video gaming ideas, which are using a new visual language or express themselves with a high symbolic value
- Researchers of future communication tools and symbol-making of a non-verbal language
- Digital media experts with creative as well as conceptual inputs for the deployment of a new visual language
